STALKING EX PARTE TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER

The petition having come on for an *ex parte* hearing, pursuant to O.C.G.A. 16-5-94 requesting that a Protective Order be issued; Petitioner alleged that Respondent has knowingly and willfully committed, or attempted to commit acts, in violation of O.C.G.A. 16-5-90 et., seq. and such acts were not at the home of the Respondent, had no legitimate purpose and that Petitioner is in reasonable fear of the Petitioner's safety (and the safety of Petitioner's immediate family; and the Court having read and considered the petition and having heard the sworn testimony of the Petitioner, the Court finds probable cause exists to believe that similar events may occur in the future, **IT IS HEREBY ORDERED AND ADJUDGED THAT:**

1.pco01,02 Respondent is enjoined and restrained from any acts, directly or indirectly, of stalking, harassing and/or intimidating the Petitioner and/or the immediate family of Petitioner. This shall also include attempting or threatening to do any of the foregoing acts.

2.pco01,04 Respondent is enjoined from approaching within 100 yards of Petitioner.

3.pco05 Respondent shall have no contact of any type, direct or indirect, or through another person, with the Petitioner or the immediate family of Petitioner, including but not limited to telephone, pager, fax, e-mail, mail, or any other means of communication. Furthermore, Respondent shall not follow Petitioner or place the Petitioner under surveillance.

4. The Petitioner and Respondent named herein shall appear before the Superior Court of DeKalb County, on the 22nd day of October 2014, at 9:00 o'clock a.m. at the DeKalb County Courthouse, 556 N. McDonough Street, Decatur, Georgia, Courtroom 1200D, to show cause why the demands of the Petitioner should or should not be granted.

5. A copy of this Order be given to law enforcement and the Respondent be served with a copy of this Order the Petition for Stalking Temporary Protective Order, instanter.

6. This Order applies in every county throughout the state of Georgia and it shall be the duty of every court and every law enforcement official to enforce and carry out the provisions of this Order pursuant to O.C.G.A. 16-5-94(e) and 19-13-4(d). Law Enforcement officers may use their arrest powers pursuant to O.C.G.A. 16-5-91 and 17-4-20 to enforce the terms of this Order.

7. These proceedings be filed with the Office of the Clerk of this Court.

8. This Court has determined that it had jurisdiction over the parties and the subject matter under the laws of the state of Georgia and the Court ordered that the Respondent be given reasonable notice and opportunity to

be heard sufficient to protect the Respondent's due process rights. This Order shall be presumed to be valid and pursuant to 18 U.S.C. 2265(a) shall be accorded **FULL FAITH AND CREDIT** by any other state, tribe or local jurisdiction as if an Order of the enforcing state, tribe or jurisdiction. The Petitioner has validly received this Stalking Ex Parte Protective Order; therefore, this Order is legally enforceable by any appropriate law enforcement official or court of any State pursuant to 18 U.S.C.A. § 2265. A copy of this order be given to law enforcement and the Respondent be served with a copy of this Order the Petition for Stalking Temporary Protective Order instanter.

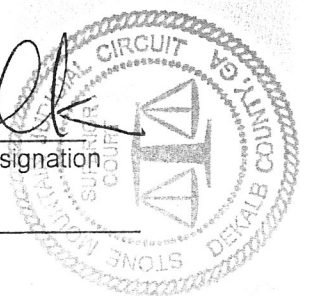

Violation of this Order May Be Punishable By Arrest

Notice to Respondent

1. Violation of this Order may result in immediate arrest and criminal prosecution that may result in jail time and/or fines and/or may subject you to prosecution and penalties for contempt of court.
2. This Order shall remain in effect unless specifically superceded by a subsequent signed and filed Order, by operation of law, or by Order of Dismissal, whichever occurs first. Only this Court can void, modify, or dismiss this Order. Either party may ask, in writing, or during any hearing, that this Court change or dismiss this Order.
3. A person commits the offense of Aggravated Stalking when such person, in violation of a temporary or permanent protective Order prohibiting this behavior follows, places under surveillance, or contacts Petitioner on public or private property for the purpose of harassing and intimidating the other person. This activity can subject the Respondent to arrest and prosecution for the felony Aggravated Stalking, which carries penalties of imprisonment for not less than 1 year nor more than 10 years and a fine up to \$10,000.00.

PETITION FOR STALKING TEMPORARY PROTECTIVE ORDER

The Petitioner, pursuant to O.C.G.A. § 16-5-94, hereby files this Petition for a Stalking Temporary Protective Order and in support shows the Court the following:

1. The Petitioner is a resident of DeKalb County, Georgia and is over the age of 18 years of age or is an emancipated minor.

2. The Respondent is a resident of DeKalb, Georgia, and may be served at 4025 Park Drive, Pine Lake, GA County, Georgia. 30072

OR

2a. Respondent is a resident of the State of Georgia. Under O.C.G.A. §§19-13-2(b) and 16-5-94(6) jurisdiction and venue are proper with this Court because the stalking occurred in the State of Georgia in DeKalb County and the Petitioner lives in DeKalb County. Respondent is subject to the jurisdiction of this Court and may be served at 4025 Park Drive Pine Lake, GA 30072.

3. On or about Sep 18, 2014, the Respondent has knowingly and willfully committed the following acts of stalking under O.C.G.A. §§ 16-5-90 et seq.

and similar events may occur in the future. These acts had no legitimate purposes, happened at places other than the residence of the Respondent, were without the consent of the Petitioner, and placed Petitioner in reasonable fear for her/his own safety and/or the safety of her/his immediate family.

These acts had no legitimate purposes, happened at places other than the residence of the Respondent, were without the consent of the Petitioner, and placed Petitioner in reasonable fear for her/his own safety and/or the safety of her/his immediate family.

THEREFORE, Petitioner requests:

- (a) That the Court set a hearing within thirty (30) days of the signing of the Order and to direct Respondent to appear before this Court and to show any reasons why the demands of the Petitioner should not be granted;
- (b) That the Respondent be served a copy of this Petition and Ex Parte Protective Order as required by law;
- (c) Order law enforcement to enforce the order;
- (d) That this Court issue an Ex Parte and Twelve month protective order to:
 - _____ order Respondent to stop harassing and intimidating Petitioner and her/his immediate family;
 - _____ order Respondent not have any direct or indirect contact with the petitioner and her/his immediate family;
 - _____ order Respondent be enjoined from approaching within _____ yards of Petitioner and Petitioner's residence;
 - _____ order Respondent refrain from the conduct toward the Petitioner as stated in this Petition;
 - _____ order Respondent to receive appropriate psychiatric or psychological services;
 - _____ award Petitioner costs and attorney fees for having to bring this action.
